# PROGRESS

Even though the project suffered some delays, we managed to complete most of the goals planned on the previous report.

The project website structure is now complete and and it is updated to our current progress, displaying all information required both about the project and other relevant documentation.

Following on the decision to redesign the website from scratch, we started outlining the website flow and features for each page. We also started sketching some mockups that need to be refined and sent to Gareth for feedback.

- Finished setting up the main structure and updated with relevant content: the project website now contains all our current information on the project as well as documentation on our ongoing progress.

Nevertheless, we tried keeping in touch via other means of communication such as emails and instant messaging in order to not lose track of the project and our completion of tasks.
